**Millions of people suffer from non-operable impaired vision. Some of them can resume driving activities with help of special telescopic aids. However, certain environmental and visual criteria should be fulfilled and person should attend a special training program, before he/she is allowed to drive safely.**

**In this presentation we will discuss the visual performance of twenty patients fitted with Bioptic systems to help them to walking around as a primary goal , and to drive their motor vehicles as a secondary goal . We will also comment on how comfortable, independent and secure, our patients felt, when they used those systems for walking around, watching TV and driving on Egyptian roads.**
