Rodney Stedall is an Optometrist providing Low Vision Services at Pretoria Eye Institute. He qualified in 1978 from the Technikon Witwatersrand with a diploma in Optometry and obtained the M.C. Optom in the UK in 1993 as well as a Certificate of Advanced Study in Optometry from the New England College of Optometry, Boston USA. In 1983 he started a private general optometric practice in Pretoria and developed an interest in the partially sighted and supervised a weekly university clinic at Prinshof School for the partially sighted. He is currently a moderator in Low Vision at the Technikon Witwatersrand. In 1996 he was invited to open a Low Vision Clinic at The Pretoria Eye Institute which today has a total of 27 Ophthalmologists in practice.

Low Vision Services is now an established practice run by Rodney and his partner. Referrals are mostly from the local ophthalmologists and optometry colleagues.
