

Aart C. Kooijman

is the Visio Chair of Videology at the University of Groningen. He is Fellow of the Graduate School of Behavioral and Cognitive Neurosciences. He graduated in 1968 in Experimental Physics at the University of Utrecht and received his Ph.D. in Medicine in Groningen. His research topics are visual optics and perception, clinical electrophysiology, and mobility of visually impaired people. Recent scientific studies concerned the ability of visually impaired people to drive and the effects of training on their performance.

He was co-organizer of the Vision1993 conference and the ECV2000 conference in Groningen. He was co-founder of the International Society of Low vision Research and Rehabilitation (ISLRR) (1996) and is co-founder and co-editor-in-chief of the scientific journal Visual Impairment Research (1999), the official journal of ISLRR (<http://www.tandf.co.uk/journals/titles/1388235X.asp>). In the Netherlands he proposed the establishment of the Foundation for Research in the field of Visual Rehabilitation and Education "InZicht".
