

Brief Bio – Gregory Goodrich, Ph.D.

Dr. Goodrich is Supervisory Research Psychologist and Optometric Research Fellowship Director at the US Department of Veterans Affairs Health Care System in Palo Alto, California. He is also an assistant clinical professor with the School of Optometry, University of California, Berkeley. His research interests include studies of low vision devices and training for near and distance, vision rehabilitation service delivery outcomes, and the demographics of visual impairment. Research projects also include the evaluation of near and distance low vision devices and their application in a wide variety of daily activities. He currently serves as treasurer for the International Society for Low-vision Research and Rehabilitation and as the president-elect of the Association for Education and Rehabilitation of the Blind and Visually Impaired. He has published numerous journal articles and book chapters and co-edits (with Aries Ardit, Ph.D.) *Low Vision: The Reference* a bibliography of the world's low vision literature.
