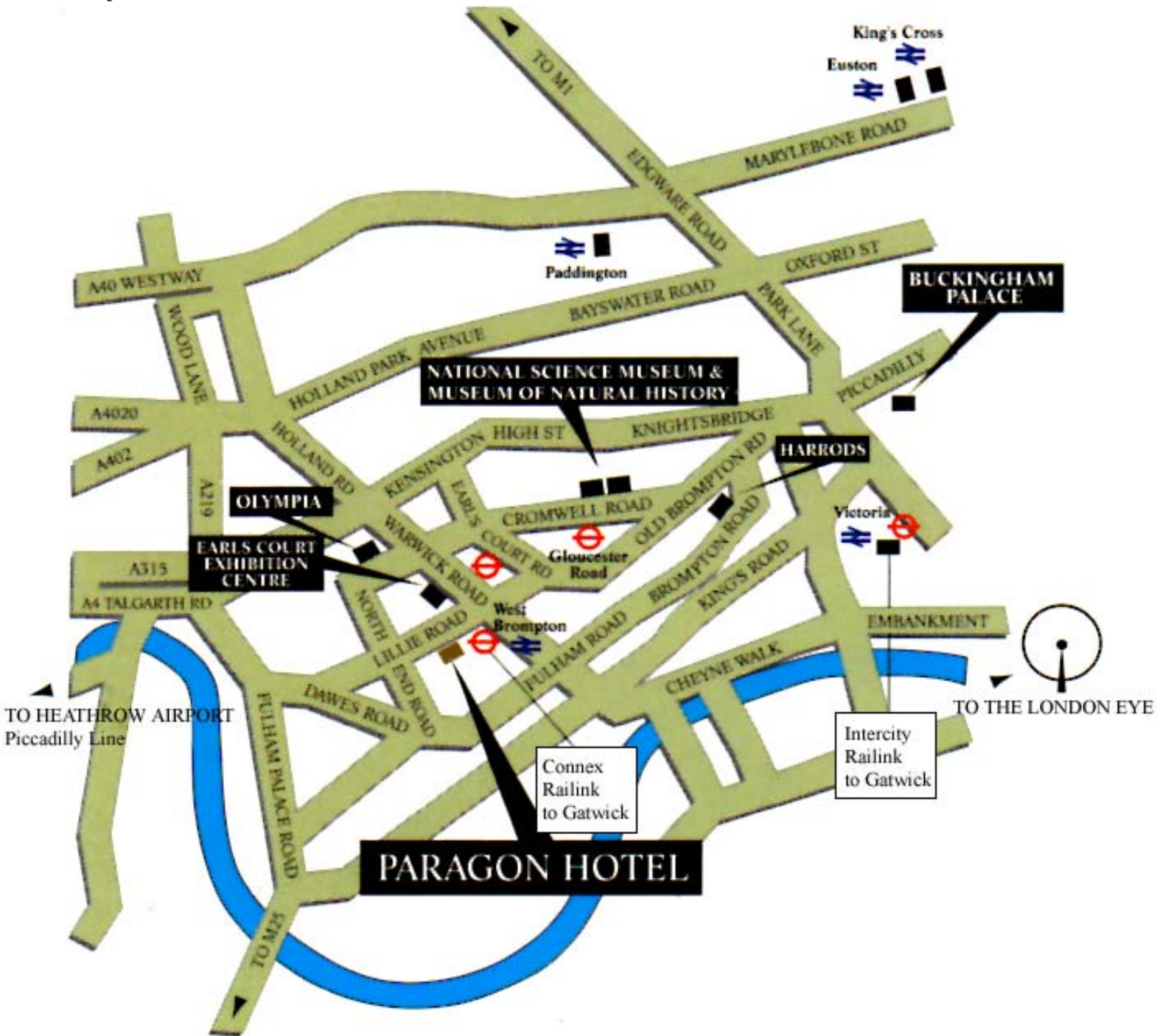

**CONFERENCE AND BANQUETING**

The hotel provides function rooms to cater for any occasion, from corporate meetings and seminars to product launches and large conferences, holding up to 1,5000 delegates. The London Eye. Westminster 20 minutes via car/tube

London's latest attraction, the London Eye is 456ft tall making it the world's highest observation wheel and London's 4th tallest structure. You will experience a totally new perspective of some of the capital's most famous landmarks and a birds-eye view across an approximately 30 mile radius of London. With 32 fully enclosed high tech capsules accommodating up to 25 people, it takes 30 minutes to complete one full 360-degree rotation.

*The Tower of London, Tower Hill 20 minutes via car/tube*

For over 900 years, the Tower of London has dominated the capital and has become one of London's most popular tourist attractions. As a Royal Palace, Fortress, Prison, Place of Execution, Arsenal, Royal Mint and Jewel House, it has witnessed many great events in British history.

*Buckingham Palace, Victoria 20 minutes via car/tube*

Buckingham house, as it was first called was built by the 1st Duke of Buckingham between 1702 and 1705, and bought by George III in 1762. After its considerable enlargement by John Nash in the 1820's, George IV renamed it Buckingham Palace. Queen Victoria was the first monarch to live there and added further extensions to the Palace during the 19th century. The palace has a fabulous collection of priceless art treasures, ornaments, porcelain tapestries and furniture, including the Coronation Throne of our present Queen.
